Forbairt Naíonraí Teo (FNT) provides advice support and guidance for Irish medium childcare, outside Gaeltacht areas. FNT was established in the early seventies to encourage quality standards in an increasing number of Irish language pre-school services. The area development officer organises in-service training for Naionra staff during each term, initial training for new staff is also organised each year through Irish in Dublin or/and the provinces. FNT co-operates with accredited training organisations to provide FETAC levels 5 and 6 (CDBO) and other accredited training as necessary.

FNT also operates a quality assurance programme (scéim ardchaighdeán) on an ongoing basis, in Irish medium services.
